
# STORYTELLING TIPS & TRICKS ...for being on camera

## Room to Edit

Feel free to watch OE's videos on YouTube to get a better understanding of how we edit.

When speaking, take short pauses between sentences and thoughts.



### We Love Your Ideas

Let us know:

 if there is a location you like better or feel more comfortable filming in

• if there are any topics you want to talk about

If we cut you off, it's just to help us with editing later.

Bring notes if you want to.

### Why?

1. it helps collect your thoughts and end on a confident stopping point, rather than trailing off into a run-on sentence.

2. it provides storytelling with pauses to make cuts that will feel more natural to the audience.


Try to **maintain a neutral facial expression** at the beginning and end of your statment.

#### Whv?

1. You may not have liked what you were saying, but it could actually be a really good take!

2. Storytelling has to cut so close to the end of your sentence that it does not feel natural.
